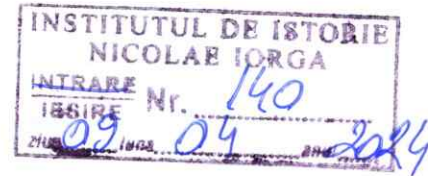
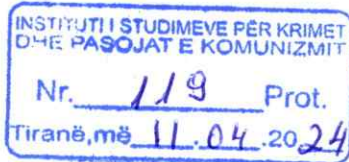

Preamble

ISCCC is a public independent institution in Albania, which mission is to investigate, research, publish and divulge knowledge on the communist dictatorship, its suppressing structure, political persecution, state machinery of control and discipline, and suffering and poverty during that period (1944-90).

„Nicolae Iorga” Institute of History, Romanian Academy, is an institute which is involved through the Program IV „Romania and Europe in the XX Century” in researching, publishing and documenting the history of communism both in Romania and Eastern European countries.

Both institutions will work to develop a series of joint research projects regarding the history of communism, to publish scholarly books AND articles, as well as to organize conferences and educational projects.

Purpose of cooperation

The purpose of this Memorandum is the cooperation in the common fields of research, publications, educational projects, international cooperation with other parties.

Points of Cooperation

Through mutual consultation, ISCCC and „Nicolae Iorga” Institute of History, Romanian Academy, will identify topics of common interest for mutual publications, translation of already published works and publication in the respective journals based on separate agreements.

„Nicolae Iorga” Institute of History, Romanian Academy, and ISCCC have the right to notify each other for conferences of mutual interests, as well as to organize common conferences, seminars and workshops, based on separate Agreements.

Exchange experience for projects related to education.

Organize common educational projects based on separate Agreements.

Apply as partner institutions in various international project calls.
